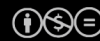

MODIFIER

Budget Cuts.

Sometimes there just isn't enough money in the piggy bank.

Play this card immediately and then place in the BURN pile. Discard either one resource from an active scientist or two from your hand.



MODIFIER

Prairie Winter.

When winter comes to the Prairies, one must spend much of their time indoors. This gives them plenty of time to do research.

Play this card immediately or keep in your hand. You may use this card as a resource on any Canadian scientist.



MODIFIER

Brain Drain.

Many Canadian scientists must move to the USA for more opportunities.

Play this card immediately then place in the BURN pile. Give to a player with a Canadian scientist in play (if yours is the only one, you have to play it on your own). This player must skip their next turn.
