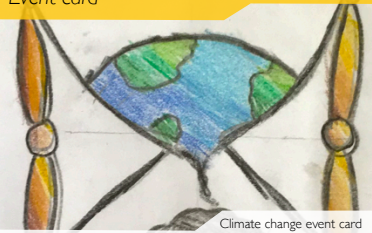


CLIMATE CHANGE

Event card



Climate change event card

PLAY: Place this card on top of any **SPECIES** card to immediately remove. In the same action, the **EVENT** card then moves to an adjacent **SPECIES** card. A game of rock-paper-scissors determines whether this card is also discarded. Continue moving the **EVENT** card and removing **SPECIES** cards until you lose. Card can only be played once per game.

FACT: This hummingbird can pick insects out of the air, and are attracted by feeders

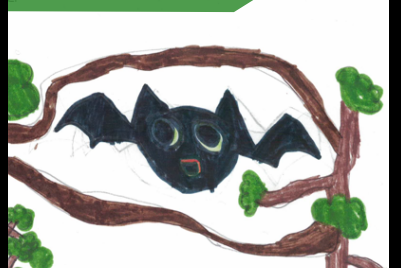

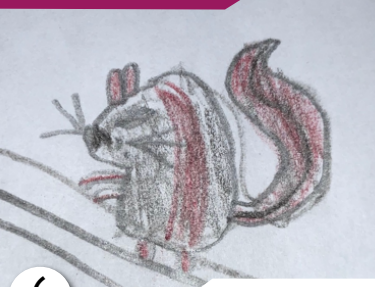

FACT: Huckleberries are high in vitamin K.



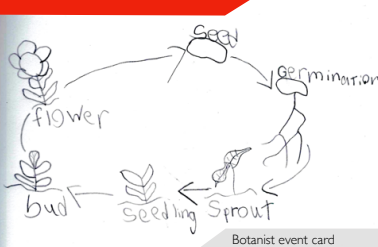

FACT: The roots make antibacterial chemicals that protect other plants like tomatoes and potatoes from pests. The petals are used as food colouring



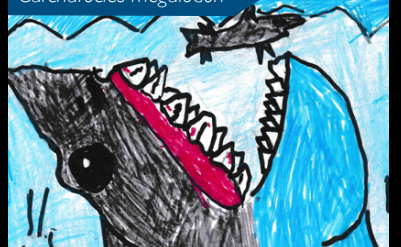
