**PLAY:** Place this card on top of any **SPECIES** card to immediately remove. In the same action, the **EVENT** card then moves to an adjacent **SPECIES** card. A game of rock-paper-scissors determines whether this card is also discarded. Continue moving the **EVENT** card and removing **SPECIES** cards until you lose. Card can only be played once per game.



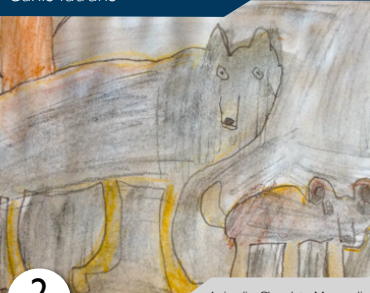

**FACT:** This hummingbird can pick insects out of the air, and are attracted by feeders



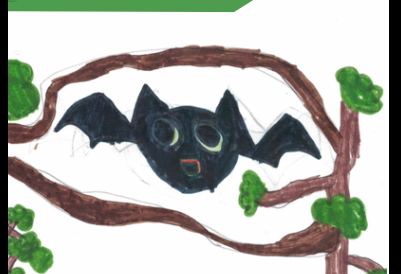

**FACT:** The black capped chickadee hides seeds and other kinds of food to eat later. It can remember thousands of hiding spots!

**FACT:** This berry is a common species in metro Vancouver and an important early fruit for native birds. The plant (except the fruit and flower) in a chemical that is toxic to humans.



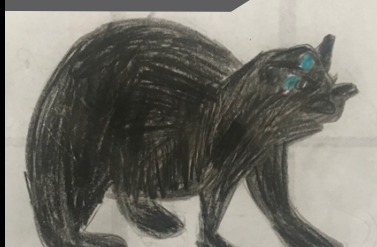

**FACT:** Hummingbirds can see ultraviolet light. Hummingbirds can flash their bright colours as well as hide them when needed.
